

20H00 Meet at ORT Airport for your flight on Emirates Airlines to Dubai.

22H20 Depart on Emirates Airlines.

Day 2: Avani Deira Dubai Hotel, Dubai (Sun, 12 November)

United Arab Emirates

The United Arab Emirates (UAE), in the eastern part of the Arabian Peninsula, extends along part of the Gulf of Oman and the southern coast of the Persian Gulf. Dubai

The capital of the Emirate of Dubai, the city of Dubai is located on the coast of the Persian Gulf and is synonymous with size and pushing the limits – first, largest, tallest. Day Itinerary

08H15 Arrive in Dubai. Met and assisted through airport procedures.



11 November 2023 - 18 November 2023

Start you touring of the Dubai's Old Quarter. This will include visiting the historical Fahidi district, crossing the creek with an Abra ride (small boat that the locals use to cross the creek), visit the gold souk and the spice souk for a walk through a quick bit of shopping. Then you will have time to visit Burj Khalifa. This is the tallest building in the world, standing at 828metres.

Transfer to hotel for check in and a quick freshen up.

16H00 Depart hotel for a Premium Desert Dune bashing experience with dinner in the desert. This will include 4x4 vehicle transfers from hotel to the desert, dune bashing drive to high dune for photo stop and sunset. Then drive down to the safari camp for camel riding photo opportunity, henna sessions, Arabic Shisha, belly dance show and buffet dinner with Barbecue and show and transfer back to hotel. Al Fahidi Historical Neighbourhood

Located on the western side of Dubai Creek, Al Fahidi Historical Neighbourhood consists of an array of buildings, shops, and cultural centres, all of which reflect the traditional style of the mid-19th century. The architecture allows visitors to gather a sense of what Dubai was like during the days of spice trade and fishing ventures.

While in the historical neighbourhood, visitors can enjoy an array of cultural and artistic activities such as exhibits and specialised museums. The area also hosts several events such as Sikka Art Fair and Heritage Week.

Dubai Creek

Located within Dubai, Dubai Creek is a saltwater creek that historically divided the city into two main sections - Deira and Bur Dubai. It was along the Bur Dubai creek area that members of the Bani Yas tribe first settled in the 19th century, establishing the Al Maktoum dynasty in the city. Today, the creek has been a part of numerous large developments and extension, including the Dubai Water Canal and Dubai Creek Harbour.

Dubai Gold Souk

Located in Deira, the heart of Dubai's commercial district, the Dubai Gold Souk is a traditional market with over 300 retailers trading almost exclusively in silver, gold, and platinum jewellery; much of it set with precious or semi-precious stones. This glittering market has long been one of Dubai's most popular attractions and with the government exercising strict control over the quality of the precious metals and stones, one can be assured of getting the real deal when buying jewellery here.

Deira Spice Souk

Also known as the Old Souk, as the name suggests it is the largest and the oldest souk in Dubai city. The spice souk has a number of narrow lanes dotted with open and closed roof spice shops. As you walk along the winding streets, you can see traders as well as shoppers haggling with the shop keepers. Bargaining is an entirely new experience and to watch the "professional hagglers" carrying on is a sight to behold. Since the Dubai spice souk is the oldest one around, it looks more traditional than the others.

Another fascinating sight is watching the wholesaler packing your purchases which were packed and shipped in Hessian pouches. This keeps the spices fresh and aromatic for a long time. Without any doubts, they are spices of the highest quality and reasonably priced at the same time. The world famous Arab dried fruits are also available. Spices and dried fruits make excellent gifts for special occasions. Food lovers can go wild and buy them to experiment authentic Arab cuisines.

The Dubai spice souk is located just next to the gold souk. The best way to get to the souk is to walk towards the wind towers on the Deira side of the creek. The souk is opened from 10 am to 10 pm every day. The best time to visit would be in the evening because afternoons could get quite warm.

At the Top Burj Khalifa

Located in downtown Dubai, At the Top Burj Khalifa offers visitors the opportunity to experience amazing views of the city from the tallest building in the world. Visitors can enjoy a personalised tour guided by a guest ambassador. The tour includes the opportunity for visitors to step out onto the highest observation deck with a height of 555 meters and view some of Dubai's most famous landmarks. After this lovely experience, visitors can enjoy signature refreshments at the SKY Lounge.



Dubai Desert Experience

A Trip to the desert is full of fun and adventure. Experience the thrill of a roller coaster ride on the sand dunes then take a pause and view the splendour of the beautiful sunset as it begins to lower over the horizon.

The journey will continue to the Bedouin Campsite in the heart of the desert and upon arrival you will refreshed with soft drinks, mineral water, tea or coffee. Freshly ground Arabic gahwa (coffee) is served while you enter the camp.

In the camp, you can take a camel for a ride or decorate your hands with a traditional 'henna' design. Alternatively, dress yourself in some traditional local clothing for some fun photo selfies. After all that – relax and recline on a carpet and pillows in the tents while waiting for the sumptuous BBQ dinner to be served. After relishing the meal, take a chance to try some shisha that comes in a variety of flavours. Before we conclude the night, a belly dancer will perform an exciting and mesmerizing show following the rhythms of traditional Arabic music.

Chennai

Chennai is Tamil Nadu's coastal capital and one of India's financial, cultural and tourism hubs. Attractions include the city's beaches, museums, shopping areas and historical sites, particularly the centrally located Kapaleeshwar Temple – a historical shrine to the goddess Shiva, featuring gaudily decorative gopurams (towers) covered with colourful carvings – and the group of ancient rock-carved temples at Mahabalipuram, a UNESCO World Heritage Site located roughly 60 kilometres from the city centre. Also of interest is the Guindy National Park, which occupies nearly three square kilometres of greenery in the city centre and is home to an array of birds, reptiles and (mainly smallish) mammals.
